# OLIVER'S CAP LEVEL 2

# **ABOUT THIS PATTERN**

This beanie takes off the morning chill for river mariners.

## **PATTERN NOTES**

This cap is knitted in the round. Directions are given for two versions: a cap with a 2" ribbed brim, and a watch cap with 4.5" of ribbing, intended to be folded up.

You can knit in one color, or you can add stripes as you desire.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

k2tog = knit 2 stitches together (decrease)

ssk = slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time to the right needle, insert left needle in front of these 2 stitches, and knit them together (decrease)

## **DIRECTIONS**

Brim:

Cast on 80 stitches. Place marker and join to work in the round, being careful not to twist.

Work in k2, p2 ribbing for 2" (or work for 4.5" for watch cap).

Hat Body:

Knit even until piece measures 6.5" from beginning of piece (or 9" for watch cap).

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# **MATERIALS**

Approximately 150 yards worsted weight yarn US size 8 16" circular and set of dpns, or size needed to get gauge Stitch marker Tapestry needle

## **GAUGE**

16 stitches & 24 rounds = 4" square in stockinette stitch

#### SIZE

One size, fits adult Cap: 9" long x 9" wide Watch Cap: 11.5"long x 9" wide

# Shape Crown:

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few stitches to knit comfortably on the circular needle.

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*K2tog, k16, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (72 sts) Knit 1 round.
*K2tog, k14, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (64 sts) Knit 1 round.
*K2tog, k12, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (56 sts) Knit 1 round.
*K2tog, k10, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (48 sts) Knit 1 round.
*K2tog, k8, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (40 sts) Knit 1 round.
*K2tog, k6, ssk, repeat from * to end of round. (32 sts) Knit 1 round.
```

\*K2tog, ssk, repeat from \* to end of round - 8 sts

Cut yarn, leaving a 6" tail. With tapestry needle, pull through remaining stitches tightly, secure end on inside. Weave in ends.

Try on the hat and enjoy!

<sup>\*</sup>K2tog, k4, ssk, repeat from \* to end of round. (24 sts) Knit 1 round.

<sup>\*</sup>K2tog, k2, ssk, repeat from \* to end of round. (16 sts) Knit 1 round.
