

# SEAFARER'S BEANIE LEVEL 2

## **ABOUT THIS PATTERN**

A double-brimmed beanie makes this hat toasty warm for ears!

## **PATTERN NOTES**

The hat looks deceptively small but will stretch when it comes off the needles. Garter stitch stretches!

To make the folded brim, you'll be joining the live stitches to the cast-on stitches. This may feel awkward at first, but work slowly and the effect is really great. Be sure to knit the first cast-on stitch with the first live stitch, and all the other stitches line up nicely.

# **DIRECTIONS**

Brim:

Cast on 84 stitches. Place marker and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist. Knit every round for 3 inches (17 rounds).

Purl one round.

Knit 18 rounds.

Fold up brim (on the purl row) and knit the cast-on edge together with the live stitches, stitch by stitch. 84 sts.

Hat Body:

\*Purl one round, knit one round. (This makes garter stitch in the round.)



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## **MATERIALS**

Approximately 150-200 yards
worsted weight yarn
US size 7 16" circular needle
and set of dpns, or size needed
to get gauge
Stitch marker
Tapestry needle

#### **GAUGE**

18 stitches & 24 rounds = 4" square in stockinette stitch 18 stitches & 36 rounds = 4" square in garter stitch

#### SIZE

Fits adult head Approximately 21" circumference x 8" tall Repeat from \* until you have worked 3 inches above the brim. End after working a purl round.

# Shape Crown:

Note: Switch to dpns when there are too few stitches to work comfortably on the circular needle.

- \*K5, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. (72 sts) Purl one round.
- \*K4, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. (60 sts) Purl one round.
- \*K3, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. (48 sts) Purl one round.
- \*K2, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. (36 sts) Purl one round.
- \*K1, k2tog, repeat from \* to end of round. (24 sts) Purl one round. K2tog to end of round. (12 sts)

# Finishing:

Cut yarn, leaving a tail of 8". With tapestry needle, pull through remaining stitches tightly, secure end on inside. Weave in ends.
