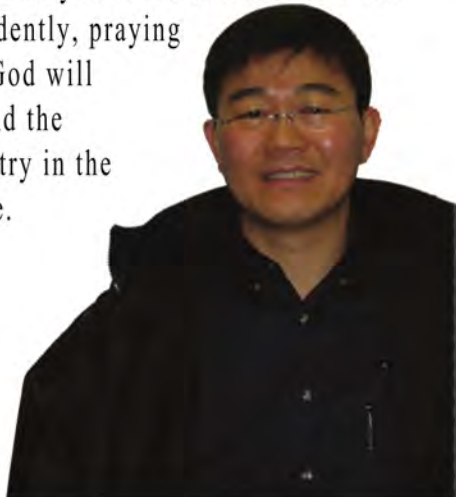


Our History

Alfred Piranian, a Philadelphia ship chandler (a businessman selling supplies to ships that enter the port.) expressed his concern for the spiritual welfare of Chinese crews to Rev. Yun Yong, a young medical artist at Temple University. Through this simple act of sharing, a seed was planted and, in 1966, the Mission To Chinese Seamen was born.

Today our work continues through Rev. Byeong Lee, who joined MCS in 1998. Rev. Lee is an ordained pastor in the Korean Presbyterian Church and is able to minister in English, Korean and Chinese. God has been gracious in His provision for the continuation of this ministry for almost 50 years. We continue to work confidently, praying that God will expand the ministry in the future.
