There was no Chinese ships in port since our last board mtg. There was also no special events in port. Then what Rev. Lee is doing when there is no Chinese ships? Mostly Rev. Lee is visiting the ships which come into our port on regular bases.

There are four kinds of ships which come into our ports in regular bases. That is Containers, Fruit carrier, Oil carrier and Car Carriers. They are all belong to different company, but the common thing is they all belong to same agent.

There are two major ship agents which refuses SCI ship visiting fee request. One is NAGA agent, and the other is Trans Marine agent. There are also shipping company which don't pay for SCI request. That is the MAERSK shipping.

SCI exclude and limits their ship visiting and transportation service to the ships which belong to these agent and company. These facts give us the ministry chance to seafarers. Most of ships that I am visiting and doing ministry these days belong to these three agents.

At Gloucester terminal, NJ, I encouraged and ministered to Philippine female seafarer(4th engineer) who works at Fruit ships.

At Penn terminal, Chester county, I met German captain and helped shopping. took him to Springfield shopping mall. He was very upset about SCI policy and will promise to call me whenever his ship come in.

At Packer Ave., I counselled Philippine seafarers. (belongs MAERSK company)

At Marcus Hook and Monroe terminal, I helped Indian and Sri Lankan seafarers. They request always for shopping service at Concord Mall. There are also American ship which brings oil from gulf of Mexico.
